



1. Suffolk Artlink will: -

- Continuously seek to improve its environmental performance
- Provide staff with education and training in environmental issues and the effects of their activities as required.
- Review its environmental performance annually.

- Its use of transport
- The recycling of packaging materials
- Minimising waste
- The use of water and energy
- The use of solvents and lead based paints
- The use of timber, particularly in paper and furniture
- Noise disturbance
- Ozone-depleting substances
